## <u>A Note from Father Carl's Desk:</u> Stations of the Cross: Each Sunday during Lent at 1 PM.

### FROM THE PASTOR

In our gospel for this First Sunday of Lent, we are told that Jesus went into the desert to be tempted by the devil. Temptations are necessary for our spiritual growth, in fact it is only after we have been able to overcome temptation that we can claim to be spiritually strong. Causes of temptation are all around us ranging from: craving for prestige and recognition, our common desires, satisfaction of the body and appetite for acquisition of power and wealth.

Jesus was tempted on his identity as the Son of God. The devil says, "If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down..." Jesus understood His identity and refused to allow Satan to redefine Him. Jesus was tempted on his authority, "All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me." Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan!... Jesus' authority was rooted in doing only what He saw the Father do." Jesus was tempted on his need for bodily food, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread."

Jesus was tempted in three areas where you and I are most tempted. Jesus needed to affirm to Satan who He was and from whom He gained His authority and his strength. One key with which we can overcome temptation just like Jesus did is by delaying and denying gratification, that is by standing firm to say no to certain demands. As we begin Lent, this could be a place to start and a resolution to follow in our daily lives.

Today, at the 11:30 Mass at Immaculate Heart of Mary, we will celebrate the Rite of Sending for our RCIA Catechumens and Candidates. This afternoon at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Peter in Chains, they will be present at the Rite of Election. As Vicar General, I will be celebrating the Rite of Election at the Cathedral for those Catechumens and Candidates in the Archdiocese. This will be the first time as Pastor, I will be celebrating both ceremonies with our RCIA Catechumens and Candidates. Please pray for these individuals who soon will be approaching the Easter sacraments.
