FROM THE PASTOR

Going into some of our classrooms and speaking during vocation week, children will ask, "What does a priest do?" As priests we have a special grace of ordination, passed on to us by the bishop on the day we were ordained. But that grace is not for ourselves. It is for the whole people of God. We don't become priests for our own whims or even for our own salvation. We accept the call to the priesthood in order to make known the love and truth of God, and to serve others, helping them in their relationship with God. As priests, the Holy Spirit acts through us when we celebrate Mass and the Sacraments. Even if we are tired, or off color, the Sacrament still works. It doesn't depend upon our degree of sanctity or being "on the ball" that day.

Some priests have other responsibilities outside of the parish to which they are called. My call extends to our Family of Parishes. We are the second largest Family of Parishes in the Archdiocese. I also serve as the Vicar General of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. The Vicar General is appointed in a diocese as the "alter ego" (other self) of the bishop to assist him in the administration and pastoral care of the diocese. He represents and acts in the place of the Bishop in his absence. I am in the downtown Pastoral Center on Wednesdays. I was appointed a Dean when I became pastor to our Family of Parishes. The dean's role is to oversee the spiritual needs of the priests in his region, to be attentive to pastoral issues in his region, and to coordinate regional pastoral responses. In our Cathedral B Deanery, there are 22 parishes which extends geographically to West Chester, Glendale, Sharonville, Montgomery, Madeira, Kenwood, Deer Park, Bond Hill, Pleasant Ridge, Oakley, Hyde Park, Mt. Lookout, East End, Columbia Tusculum, Mt. Adams. As Dean, I chair Deanery Meetings and celebrate Confirmations in the Deanery parishes. This year, I have about ten Confirmations in our Deanery Parishes. We are the largest Deanery in the Archdiocese. I serve as a police chaplain to the Cincinnati Police Department in Criminal Investigative Services, the CDRT Riot Team and the SWAT Team and also with the Hamilton County Sheriff's Department.

In all of these roles, a great reward of the priesthood is seeing the change which God's grace can make in people's lives, giving them new hope, new purpose, new courage and understanding. A priest is a laborer in the Lord's vineyard. At the end we must say to the Lord: we have done no more than our duty, and please forgive the occasions when we have done less than our duty!

It would be worthwhile to ask Fr. King, Fr. Alex and Fr. Thomas about their vocations. Each priest is involved in different ministries in their lives. Thank you for allowing us to serve you in our Family of Parishes.
