Note from Father Carl:

Saturday and Sunday, June 1st and June 2nd, is the feast of the Body and Blood of our Lord. This is the week-end when we will resume having the chalice of consecrated wine available for all who want to drink from the chalice.

There will be 2 ministers of Holy Communion instead of just 1: the minister (riverside) with hosts and the minister (Kellogg Ave side) with the Chalice and purificator.

As you know, when the minister says "Body of Christ," we respond "Amen" and bow our heads.

Similarly, when the minister says "Blood of Christ," we respond "Amen" and bow our heads.

Remember, the Lord Jesus Whom we receive is living; where his body or blood is present, the entire Lord Jesus is present.

Saturday 4/27 & Sunday 4/28 there is a second collection – Knights of Columbus Measure Up: Adults and Children with disabilities.

Health Ministries is a vital force in the St. Gregory Family of Parishes. There is a Health Commission comprised of members from our family of parishes as well as Health Ministries in each of our parishes. They sponsor health workshops, blood pressure checks and are a resource for the parishioners and staff of our family of parishes. We have hired a Director of Health Ministries for the St. Gregory the Great Family of Parishes. Her name is Kendall Keiser. She is a registered nurse grounded in faith with a passion for supporting people's spiritual and physical health and wellness. She is coming to us from Hospice of Southwest Ohio where she had been providing care for individuals with terminal illness and providing emotional and spiritual support alongside the pastoral care team. Kendall will collaborate with the leadership staff to carry out the Pathways Team recommendations put forth in the Beacons of Light guidelines. She will provide Pastoral Care, serve as staff liaison to the St. Gregory the Great Family of Parishes Health Commission, provide health education, assist in referrals and oversee bereavement ministry. Kendall began her ministry with us on April 15. We welcome Kendall to our family of parishes.

Today at St. John Fisher, First Communion will take place at the 11:00 Mass. Congratulations to all our First Communicants.
