This weekend our gospel reflects on the Beatitudes.

- "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." Step by step, we journey on our Christian walk. <u>Humility</u> is the first step, a recognition of our spiritual poverty. Our hearts are receptive and amenable to the call of Christ.
- "Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted." Godly sorrow is the next step of our journey. Our heartfelt desire is for the mercy and forgiveness of our Savior, His comfort and peace.
- "Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth."

Along our journey, we seek to acquire the characteristics of Christ.

"Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy."

We seek to cultivate the compassion of Christ. Unlike the worldly... merely looking out for themselves, we look to others... loving them as Jesus loves us.

"Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of Me. Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven."

What appears to be a retelling of the first with the same reward — the kingdom of heaven. Jesus warns His disciples that they will <u>face opposition</u> and persecution because of their faith in Him. Troubles and trials will come our way... all a test of our true discipleship.
