Tuesday, February 11 is the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. The late Saint Pope John Paul II declared this day a Day of Prayer for the Sick. Illness and suffering is an immutable part of the human condition. The need to endure them in isolation, however, is not. However, illness can also sanctify, reconcile, and open hearts.
