FROM THE PASTOR:

This Thursday, our new Archbishop, Most Reverend Robert G. Casey, will be installed as the eleventh bishop of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. The apostolic nuncio, Cardinal Cupich of the Archdiocese of Chicago among other bishops and civil dignitaries will be in attendance for the installation. The last installation was Archbishop Schnurr in 2009. Archbishop Casey was ordained to the Priesthood on May 21, 1994 and was consecrated a bishop on September 17, 2018 in Chicago, IL. Archbishop Casey is a graduate of the University of St. Mary of the Lake in Mundelein, Illinois. Most recently, Archbishop Casey served as the Vicar General of the Archdiocese of Chicago and Auxiliary Bishop of Chicago. He has been pastor of parishes in the Archdiocese of Chicago from 2003-2018. Archbishop Casey has run various marathons including Paris, France and is scheduled to run a marathon this year in Dublin, Ireland. Archbishop Casey has helped guide the Archdiocese of Chicago through a period of reorganization and renewal and prepared it for a blessed future. He will carry this experience and his pastoral heart to his new post as Archbishop of Cincinnati and we wish him well as he continues his service to the people of God.



JUBILEE 2025 During the Holy Year of 2025, Pope Francis directed that Holy Doors be sealed and opened only at the major basilicas in the city of Rome. Therefore, there is no Holy Door at the Cathedral Basilica of Saint Peter in Chains. However, the Cathedral is a site designated for jubilee pilgrimages and pious visits. Emmanuel Church in Dayton and the Maria Stein Shrine of the Holy Relics are also designated Jubilee Sacred Sites. A visit to any of these locations, including prayer for the Church and the Holy Father's intentions, along with reception of Holy Communion and sacramental confession, allows an individual to gain a plenary indulgence (all the usual conditions being fulfilled).



Laetare Sunday

The Fourth Sunday of Lent is called **Laetare Sunday**, from the first words of the Introit at Mass, "Laetare Jerusalem" ("Rejoice, O Jerusalem").

Like Gaudete Sunday midway through Advent, Laetare reminds us of the event we look forward to at the end of the penitential season and the joy in anticipation of the Resurrection. The vestments for this day will be rose, as they are on Gaudete Sunday in Advent.
