FROM THE PASTOR:

The Order of Christian Initiation for Adults or OCIA is a formal program whereby adults called the catechumens are formally admitted into the Church and receive the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. As in the early Church, OCIA is a gradual process that involves the whole community of the faithful. Not only does OCIA prepare individuals for entrance into the Church, it allows the members of the Church to renew their faith. During the course of OCIA, which usually last for a year, the individual follows a spiritual journey of catechetical instruction and practice spiritual improvement through prayer. The sponsors and parish community assist the catechumens by their example and support. During this time, the catechumens usually attend the Liturgy of the Word at the Sunday mass, and are dismissed after the homily, since they cannot receive the Eucharist yet.

This Sunday at the 9:30 Mass at Immaculate Heart of Mary Church, the Rite of Sending is celebrated. The Rite of Sending falls on the same day as the Rite of Election and coincides with the first Sunday of Lent. Before the Rite of Sending, the catechumens inscribe their names in the Book of Elect as a pledge of fidelity. At the Rite of Sending, the sponsors will testify and the catechumens will affirm their intention to join the Church. The Church then makes its "election" of these catechumens to receive the Sacraments of Initiation, and sends them off to see the Archbishop.

The Rite of Election is celebrated this afternoon at 2:00 at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Peter in Chains. At the Rite of Election, the sponsors will further testify to the catechumens' intention to join the Church and the catechumens will affirm their decision. The catechist coordinator then presents the Book of Elect followed by the catechumens to the Archbishop for blessings. The catechumens now begin a Period of Purification and Enlightenment. This is the final, intense preparation for the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation. Over the next five Sundays of Lent, the elect will be presented for the three scrutinizes, the presentation of the Creed and Lord's Prayer. This period concludes with the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. As we draw closer to the celebration of Easter, we pray for the elect and the candidates who will be entering the Catholic Church this Easter. Fr. Steve

REMINDER: The **40**-day season of Lent which is 40 days of prayer, fasting and almsgiving begins on Ash Wednesday March 5,2025 and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday, April 17, 2024.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday **are obligatory days of fasting for Catholics from the** age of 18 to 59, meaning only one full meal and two smaller meals not equal to a full meal are permitted. **Abstinence from meat is required of all over age 14**.

The Church asks that, if possible, the fast on Good Friday, the "paschal fast," be continued until the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday to honor the suffering and death of Jesus and prepare more fully for His resurrection.

Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat from the age of 14.
