## THE PASTOR

Lent is slowly coming to a close. Next Sunday is Palm Sunday which begins what is known as Holy Week, starting with Palm Sunday and concluding at sundown on Holy Thursday immediately preceding the Easter Triduum. It is the most intense period of the season, commemorating the Passion of Jesus Christ, including his entry into Jerusalem, the Last Supper, and His crucifixion. Holy Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday represent Jesus' clearing the temple, being anointed at Bethany, and being betrayed by Judas. [Holy Thursday](#) celebrates the Last Supper, the institution of the Eucharist, and the arrest in the Garden of Gethsemane. [Good Friday](#) commemorates the crucifixion and death of Jesus. [Holy Saturday](#) is the Easter Vigil which reflects on Jesus in the tomb. Holy Week is a time of deep reflection, prayer, and, for many, the conclusion of Lenten fasting, which officially ends on Holy Thursday to begin the [Easter Triduum](#). It emphasizes a "true inner conversion of heart" as we prepare for the Resurrection.

Join us for those services that week: Holy Thursday at 7:00 pm at Guardian Angels, Good Friday: Immaculate Heart of Mary at 12 noon, Guardian Angels at 12:30 pm and St. John Fisher at 1:00 and 7:00 pm. Holy Saturday at 9:00 pm. at Immaculate Heart of Mary.

The Archbishop extends an invitation for the faithful to attend the Chrism Mass at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Peter in Chains on Tuesday of Holy Week at 4:00 pm in which the Sacred Oils are consecrated for the Sacraments.
