This coming week, Archbishop Casey will confirm our seventh-grade classes at Guardian Angels on Wednesday, May 6, Friday May 8 at Immaculate Heart of Mary and on Tuesday, May 19 at Immaculate Heart of Mary. Our candidates have prepared over a period of time, and they're dressed up in their Sunday best and everybody's here to celebrate with them. When they say, "Yes, I want to be confirmed, what are they saying yes to?" They are saying yes, not to a ceremony, but to Jesus. They are professing, "I want to follow Jesus Christ. I want to be his disciple just like those first disciples who dropped everything and followed Jesus." They are saying, "I want to follow Jesus." That means they have to live in a certain way because Jesus taught us values that were very special to him — very important in making us the best people we can be. When we say, "I want to follow Jesus," we mean, "I want to follow his teachings, I want to live according to his way, his values." That means something very important for all of us. It means we have to be very serious about trying to listen to God's word — when Jesus speaks to us — watch how we act so we follow his example. This is a good time to reflect on our own confirmations and ask ourselves if we are living out Jesus' values in our everyday lives.
