October and May

For many years St Jerome's parish has prayed the rosary each Tuesday before the 7:30pm Mass. This is a very fine practice and I want it to continue.

However, it has become very difficult for me as the leader. Last May I goofed a few times and fell asleep as well. So, I recommend the following:

I open the church at 7:00pm. Those who would like to pray the rosary should come early and begin the Rosary at 7:15pm. They should be finished about 7:30pm and then I will begin Mass.

Those who come may choose someone to lead the Rosary; or each may pray the Rosary silently.

I pray the Rosary daily; but I am finished by noon each day

THE PASTOR

On Tuesday, September 15 from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, the Cincinnati Police SWAT Team will be doing their monthly training at the Former Sister's House at McNicholas High School and the Guardian Angels Rectory. The Bearcat and SWAT vehicles will be on both campuses, and SWAT Team Officers will be in full gear. The SWAT Team trains each month and the Lieutenant Commander after touring both houses felt it would be good for a training. In this way, there is no need to be alarmed as this is not a real SWAT situation. As a chaplain to the SWAT Team, I will be present for their training.

What is SWAT? The Special Weapons and Tactics Team is a specialized unit within the Cincinnati Police Department comprised of highly trained members. Since its implementation, SWAT's goal is to provide for the safe execution of search warrants, dignitary protection and hostage negotiation situations.

S.W.A.T. provides a tactical response to barricaded subjects, active shooter incidents, terrorism and the handling of any critical incident which would

require extensive tactical skills. S.W.A.T. provides the City of Cincinnati with a self-sufficient tactical team, utilizing special skills and tools. SWAT is an additional responsibility to the Officer's primary work assignment.

SWAT is comprised of:

1. The entry team is the largest of the five elements and is comprised of members who receive specialized entry/tactical training and firearms training.
2. The breaching team is responsible for opening secured doors, windows and clearing blocked avenues of entrance for SWAT team to make its safe entry. It is trained in ballistic, mechanical, energetic, and thermal breaching.
3. The sniper team specializes in precision marksmanship. It's main objective is to obtain real-time intelligence and relay information back to SWAT leadership.
4. The crisis negotiations team is considered a valuable link in saving the life of the person in crisis, through communication.
5. The technical team are specially trained in the use of drones, robots and other technical tools.

As their chaplain, I have learned a great deal about strategic thinking and approaching situations with the utmost caution. Whether on a search warrant, the scene of an armed barricaded subject or a training exercise, I pray for each and every member of the SWAT Team for their safety that they will return to their families after the situation is resolved. Please pray for these men and women who keep us safe.
